





Importance of this Educational Excursion:

As the subject of Geography mostly based on the nature and society students always want to observed and identify the physical features in nature which they have read on their books and they also want to know about the different cultures and livelihood of the people as it is the part of social geography. At Darjeeling Mall students talk with the local shop owners and had known that some shop owners are local and some had come from different villages. They also had known that at off season or the time of snowfall they went to their villages. They could not visually expressed Kanchenjunga totally because of cloud cover. At Ghoom Monastery, Peace Pagoda and Japanese temple they visualize their architecture, culture. At Rock Garden they can identify cascade and plunge pool. At Tenzing rock, they can observe the rock beds, Dip. Somewhere in between the journey they identify 'Nappe' with the help of the teachers. They can watch the tea cultivation. At Zoo they can watch different types of flora and fauna of hilly regions. At Takdah Orchid Centre they see different types of orchids. At Lamhata Eco park, students trek 750 mt and they can visualise how the weather changes with altitude. All over the tour they can see mainly Darjeeling Kurseogn Range of Eastern Himalaya and in some places Singalila Range. They can watch how the natural vegetation changes with altitude from Deciduous Forest in Terai Region to Coniferous Forest in hilly region. We had captured some moments during our excursion and both the students and teachers had develop a family bonding.
