MotijheelPark holds historical importance as it was part of the palace grounds of nawab Siraj-ud-Daulah, the first independent nawab of Bengal before British rule. The area around the Motijheel lake served as his residence, and the nearby grounds witnessed several key events in the early British colonial journey. Motijheel, the cradle of British rule in India, stands witness to a remarkable turning point in Indian history. A 350-acre oxbow lake formed out of an abandoned bed of river Bhaghirathi, the Motijheel, derived its name from extensive pearl cultivation during the nawabi period. The jheel was famous for raising golden tinted pearls extracted from union margaritifera species.
